ACTIVITIES TO REPORT	 Planting On 17 November, about 20 volunteers planted the Miyawaki forest and about 750 saplings of hedging. Five children from Landulph School came with their parents to see their square being planted. On 30 November, 7 volunteers cleared the bank by the track ready for new material from the pond to be put there. On 6 December, LOG was visited by Ben Noon a National Trust ranger at Cotehele. He brought us a bag of wild flower meadow seed collected from South Cornwall as part of the Cornish Coastal Meadows Project. He advised, this seed needs to be sown now so that it has frost to germinate. He gave us notes on the cutting regime for the wild flower meadow. On 8 December, despite high winds and no power, 10 volunteers, rescued the Miyawaki canes that had blown over, planted several hundred bulbs, sowed the wild flower seed on the bank below the top picnic area, and constructed a dead hedge. Cornwall Sustainability Award Although we did not win the award, our film was shown and there were worthy winners. Meeting 2 December 2024 Agreed priorities for spending including using remaining in picnic bench budget as a variation in December claim (which has to be in by 5 December). A total of £32,759.40 has now been claimed. Four noticeboards discussed: a welcome board, information boards on bulbs and Miyawaki, and a polite dos and donts board 24 feet of living willow to be planted near the play area in January/.February Dipping platform no longer required as dipping can be done from the boardwalk bridge FIPL Panel plan to visit LOG on 3 February. Tree planting planned on Sunday, 26 January, 12-3pm. Team would like to hold a Wassail in both Duke Orchard & Duchess Green on 26 January after tree planting.
