	South West Water have been contacted about the supply to the site and asking for the meter to be disconnected at the meter. The leakage team were on site and have confirmed that there was a huge leak. We have painted the meter cover so that the meter (one of many by the school) can be easily identified going forward.
	Octopus Energy needs to be contacted to transfer the account to the parish name and then we can either ask for it to be disconnected or obtain an account without standing charge.
	We have a list of local clubs that might be interested (unlikely though) and we will contact them in February. We can then start consulting on recreational uses for the parish.
