ACTIVITIES TO REPORT	 Meeting 4 February 2025 Carol Hammond has joined the Working Group. Payment for claims for November and December received. January claim submitted for £7207.91. Remaining in grant: £8957.53. Notified by FIPL that variations between budget headings should be exception; this has had an impact on project priorities. Discussed grant applications for Community Chest (submitted) and Community Levelling Up Programme (CLUP) due by 28 February. FIPL Panel visit postponed until April. Despite the poor weather: 28 fruit trees, 100 snowdrops and willow arch were all planted in Duchess Green – thanks volunteers. New entrance gates and fencing installed in Duchess Green. Overall policy on noticeboards in Duchess Green agreed. Discussed whether dogs should be allowed in Duchess Green (FIPL grant stipulated no dogs in either field). WG agreed no dogs in Duchess Green, year trial of dogs on short leads in Duke Orchard – but this is subject to Marsh Farm approval. A donated derelict small tool shed is being refurbished for Duchess Green. Entrance fence for Duke Orchard Completed by volunteer. Volunteer day and wassail postponed to 16 February due to poor weather. Visits to Landulph Orchard Green 8 February Dominic Martyn, Environment Agency visited and advised on pond, water quality and photographic record. Recorded visits to the Orchards in January 14, February 3 Beekeeper who visited is going to send a proposal to site hives in Duke Orchard Clare Tagg, Martin Worth
